

THE GROUP PHOTOGRAPH

When Andrew Tatham discovered a group photograph of the officers of the 8th Royal Berkshire Regiment, including his great-grandfather, taken at their training camp on Salisbury Plain in July 1915 his aim was to explore who those officers were - where they had come from, what happened to them, and what their families were doing now. He wanted to put the First World War in the context of the stories of these men and their families.

Andrew has produced an animated film showing all their family trees growing over 136 years, mixed in with images of their families and historical time markers, with contemporary music, and with the cycles of the moon and the seasons.
