CHORAL COUNTDOWN at St Clement Danes in the Strand Sunday, 2 March 2014


The Brandenburg Choral Festival is London's biggest and broadest annual choral celebration; it exists as a platform for amateur choirs to perform in prestigious London venues.

St Clement Danes is the 'Oranges and Lemons' church opposite the Royal Courts of Justice in the Strand. Although the first church on the site was reputedly founded in the 9th century by the Danes, the current building was completed in 1682 by Sir Christopher Wren. Wren's building was gutted during the Blitz and not restored until 1958 when it was adapted for its current function as the central church of the Royal Air Force. Features include a Grinling Gibbons pulpit, Samuel Johnson statue, reredos by Ruskin Spear and windows by Carl Edwards. 'Oranges and Lemons' play the Bells of St Clement's - each day at 9 am, noon, 3 pm and 6 pm.

You and your friends are invited to a concert at St Clement Danes on Sunday, 2 March. The programme by the City of Oxford Choir, conducted by Duncan Aspden, will include:
